#### Who benefits from Hospice?

People who have tried curative measures and are ready to focus on comfort and pain management or avoid extreme life sustaining measures.

Hospice care is the preferred choice for the following people with limited life expectancy diagnosis like:

- Alzheimer's disease
- Cancer
- Cardiovascular
- HIV/AIDS
- Liver/Gastrointestinal disease
- Pulmonary disease
- Neurological disease
- Renal disease
- Stroke

Hospice Care is provided where the patient resides. Care is provided primarily in the patient's place of residence, whether in the family home, nursing facility or assisted living environment. Short-term stays at an inpatient hospice unit can also be arranged as needed to better meet comfort and symptom management goals in more difficult or complex cases.
